What is the Holland's Theory?



- Dr. John Holland developed a personality theory that claims a person's interests and preferred work environment can be loosely classified into six broad areas.
- Choosing a career, college, or major that fits your Holland personality-type is a good starting point to college and career satisfaction.
- Fun fact: Dr. Holland received his Ph.D. from the University of Minnesota

Holland's Hexagon of Personality and Careers



Personality is complex, therefore, most people will find they have strength in 2-3 areas.

Definitions

Realistic: Realistic occupations frequently involve work activities that include practical, hands-on problems and solutions. They often deal with tools, machines, and real-world materials like wood, tools, and machinery. Many of the occupations require working outside, and do not involve a lot of working closely with others.

Investigative: Investigative occupations frequently involve working with ideas, and require an extensive amount of thinking. These occupations often involve searching for facts and figuring out problems mentally.

Artistic: Artistic occupations frequently involve working with forms, designs and patterns. They often require self-expression and the work is often without following a clear set of rules.
